MEMORANDUM FOR ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE ARMY (MANPOWER
AND RESERVE AFFAIRS)

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority – National Security Personnel System

1. References:

a. Title 5, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 9901.

b. DoD 1400.25-M, DoD Civilian Personnel Management System, Chapter 1900, Subchapter 1910, General, dated December 1, 2008, subject: National Performance Management System.

c. Secretary of the Army Memorandum, dated May 13, 2009, subject: Delegation of Authority – National Security Personnel System (hereby rescinded).

2. Pursuant to my authority under, and in accordance with referenced regulations, I hereby delegate to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs) the authority and responsibilities established in Chapter 1900 of the DoD 1400.25-M for the implementation of the National Security Personnel System (NSPS) within the Department of the Army.

3. I have determined that supplementation of Chapter 1900 of DoD 1400.25-M is necessary and delegate to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs) the authority to approve supplementation. Pursuant to subchapter (SC) 1910.6.4., no further delegation of the authority to approve supplementation is authorized.

4. Although not a limitation on your authority to act in my behalf, in those cases specified above where your proposed decision represents a change in precedent or policy; is of significant White House, Congressional, Department, or public interest; or has been, or should be, of interest or concern to me, for any reason, you will brief me prior to the decision unless the exigencies of the situation preclude such action. Continue my practice of coordination with the Office of the Army General Counsel.

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5. This delegation is effective immediately and expires September 30, 2013, unless earlier revoked or superseded.
